History Majors Checklist

The following checklist is intended to assist students in determining which courses they need in order to meet the requirements for a degree in History. It is an informal document that is intended to supplement the Registrar's Audit.

PREAMBLE: DECLARING A MAJOR

Before they can register as a major in History, a student must complete History 101/102 and six semester hours (2 courses) at the 200 level, and university regulations require that students declare a major (in something!) by the beginning of their third year. To declare a major in history does not require the approval of the History Department, although we would be happy to consult and advise. All a student need do to declare their major is to fill out the required form at the Registrar's Office.

A. GENERAL DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Please consult the calendar to ensure that you meet the **general UPEI requirements** for an Arts degree. These are the principal ones:

- 120 semester hours of credit
- Of the 42 semester hours required for a major, **at least 30** semester hours must be completed with grades of 60% or better _____
- At least one-half of the courses for a degree must be completed at UPEI
- In the last 60 semester hours of course work, **no more than 12** can be completed at a university other than UPEI
- Beginning in 2008-09, all graduating students must have Global Issues 151 and one other writing intensive course _____
- Any student registered **before** 2008-09 must have English 101 and one other English course to graduate _____
- No more than 48 semester hours of credit can be taken at the introductory level (except in Bachelor of Music)
- To graduate in the current academic year students must make formal application to graduate (which can be done on-line using your campus log-in) by 31 October of the academic year in which they expect to complete the requirements.
