\$500.00 annually to be awarded in the Fall Awards cycle.

Criteria: will be granted to a returning student who is a deserving music student with outstanding performance ability, and whose calibre would normally allow them to compete in a national competition. Preference will be given to a piano major. The successful recipient will be recommended by the Chair of the UPEI Music Department in consultation with Music Department faculty.

If a suitable candidate is not identified in any given year, the award funds will remain in the award account for future student recipients.

MARY O. KINCH MEMORIAL MUSIC EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIPS – Two \$800 SCHOLARSHIPS WILL BE AWARDED TO STUDENTS ENTERING THE FIFTH YEAR OF THE BACHELOR OF MUSIC EDUCATION PROGRAMME. ELIGIBLE RECIPIENTS WILL BE NOMINATED BY THE MUSIC EDUCATION FACULTY BASED ON THEIR DEMONSTRATED PERFORMANCE AND POTENTIAL FOR SUCCESS DURING THEIR FIRST BLOCK OF TEACHING INTERNSHIP, TOGETHER WITH A MINIMUM 80% AVERAGE IN THE ELEMENTARY MUSIC EDUCATION (353-354), SECONDARY MUSIC EDUCATION (453-454), AND PHILOSOPHY OF MUSIC EDUCATION (251) COURSES.
