Toxicology and Analytical Services – Sample Submission Guidelines

- Serum, fish fillet and tissue samples should be frozen prior to and during shipment.
- Whole blood samples should be chilled at 0-5°C prior to and during shipment.
- Plastic containers should not be used for samples submitted for pesticide analysis. Tissues
 intended for pesticide analysis can be wrapped in aluminum foil prior to placement in sample
 bags and should be frozen prior to and during shipment.
- Serum submitted for vitamin analysis should be removed from the clot immediately after the
 clot is formed. Light should be avoided as much as possible during sample preparation and the
 sample tube should be sealed tightly. The sample should be submitted as soon as possible and
 should be frozen prior to and during shipment.
- If circumstances limit the amount of sample available for submission, it may be possible to
 perform the analysis on a smaller scale. Please <u>Contact Us</u> if you are unable to submit the
 minimum amount of sample required.
