The Department of Pathology & Microbiology at the Atlantic Veterinary College (AVC) is currently holding a Graduate Student Scholarship Competition. Two scholarships will each provide a maximum annual stipend of \$15,000/annum. The awards will be made to two exceptional candidates who are starting their graduate degree at the AVC as early as September 01, 2017.

Canadian and International students holding a BSc, MSc or DVM (or equivalent) credentials with excellent academic records and relevant background experience are encouraged to apply. Candidates will be selected based on prior academic performance and future promise as a researcher. Each successful candidate must meet the AVC graduate admission requirements, be able to identify a suitable program that is currently available at the AVC, and identify a supervisor able to provide additional stipend to meet the minimum and recommended stipend support. An applicant is required to contact a potential supervisor who is willing to support their program.

Interested candidates should submit a letter of interest, curriculum vitae, official transcripts of University grades, and the names of three referees. Please include the e-mail address and phone number of each referee. The deadline for the competition is **Monday, May 29, 2017**.
