Master of Education in Leadership in Learning Focus on Education for Environmental Sustainability

This Master of Education in Leadership in Learning with a focus on Education for Environmental Sustainability is designed for educators working in a wide variety of contexts including out of school contexts. This cohort will examine research, theories, and practice concerning education for environmental sustainability, with a focus on problem based learning, inquiry, and building an environmentally sustainable culture.



SPECIAL FEATURES OF THIS COHORT:

- Ten courses focused on issues of theory, practice and research in education for environmental sustainability.
- Summer courses are on campus and fall; winter and spring courses are online.
- Competitive tuition fees.
- Program completion within 25 months.
- Starting July 2016.

ADMISSION CRITERIA

- An undergraduate or graduate degree from an approved university with an average of 70% or higher in the last 20 courses (60 credit hours). An applicant who lacks a degree, or an applicant who possesses a degree with an academic average under 70%, may be considered for admission under exceptional circumstances.
