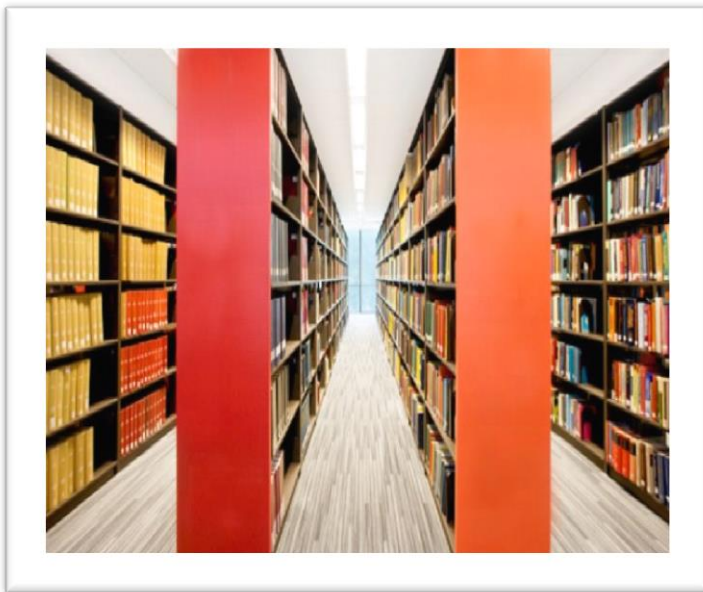

Master of Education in Leadership in Learning Focus on School Librarianship Online Cohort 2016

This Master of Education in Leadership and Learning with a focus on School Librarianship is designed to support educators working in school libraries in a wide variety of contexts. This cohort will examine research, theories, and practice concerning school library programs, collections management, and building a culture of reading in the digital age.



SPECIAL FEATURES OF THIS COHORT:

- 10 courses delivered online
- 3 courses focused on issues of theory and practice in school librarianship
- 7 courses focused on theories and research in education and leadership
- Competitive tuition fees
- Program completion within 30 months
- Starting September 2016

ADMISSION CRITERIA

- An undergraduate or graduate degree from an approved university with an average of 70% or higher in the last 20 courses (60 credit hours). An applicant who lacks a degree, or an applicant who possesses a degree with an academic average under 70%, may be considered for admission under exceptional circumstances.
