## **Master of Education Focus on 21<sup>st</sup> Century Teaching & Learning Online Cohort 2016**

Students in the 21st Century Teaching & Learning Cohort will join a virtual community of practitioners learning about digital technologies and using them to focus on 21st Century ideas about critical pedagogy, educational leadership, authentic assessment, project-based learning, and global education. The Cohort will explore theories, research and practices relevant to student engagement and learning and complete a small action research project.



### **FEATURES OF THIS SPECIAL COHORT:**

- 10 courses (delivered completely online).
- All courses will focus on teaching and learning in 21<sup>st</sup> Century contexts.
- Program completion within 30 months.
- Competitive tuition fees.

### **ADMISSION CRITERIA**

- An undergraduate or graduate degree from an approved university with an average of 70% or higher in the last 20 courses (60 credit hours). An applicant who lacks a degree, or an applicant who possesses a degree with an academic average under 70%, may be considered for admission under exceptional circumstances.
