MASTER OF EDUCATION (MEd) IN LEADERSHIP IN LEARNING

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Students in this Master of Education (MEd) 21st Century Teaching and Learning Cohort will join a virtual community of practitioners learning about digital technologies and using them to focus on 21st century ideas about critical pedagogy, educational leadership, authentic assessment, project-based learning, and global education. This cohort will explore theories, research and practices relevant to student engagement and learning, and complete a small action research project.

ADMISSION CRITERIA

An undergraduate or graduate degree from an approved university with an average of 70% or higher in the last 20 courses (60 credit hours). An applicant who lacks a degree, or an applicant who possesses a degree with an academic average under 70%, may be considered for admission under exceptional circumstances.
