Focus on 21ST CENTURY TEACHING AND LEARNING (fully online)



Tentative - Program Schedule for July 2020 to December 2022

ED 6110 Introduction to Research (Required)	This course develops an understanding of qualitative and quantitative research methodologies for 21 st Century teaching and learning. *6 Week Intensive, July – August	Online
ED 6260 Technology: Leadership in Learning (Elective)	In this course, students examine and critique current research trends in information and communication technology with a focus on educational uses of digital technologies. *12 Weeks, September - December	Online
ED 6130 Qualitative Research Design (Required)	In this course, students study the development of qualitative research methodology and explore approaches drawn from this model that are used frequently by educational researchers. *12 Weeks, January - April	Online
ED 6150 Educational Leadership (Required)	This course examines aspects of leadership that impact on schools and explores models of effective leadership in 21 st Century Contexts. *6 Week Intensive, May - June	Online
ED 6140 Theories of Research and Learning (Required)	This course familiarizes students with theories and principles of learning in 21 st Century contexts with a focus on student engagement. *6 Week Intensive, July – August	Online
ED 6250 Curriculum: Leadership in Learning (Required)	This course examines theories of curriculum and assessment including exploration of project-based learning. *12 Weeks, September - December	Online
ED 6190 Critical Pedagogy (Required)	This course examines historical, economic, political, cultural, and social contexts that are shaping 21 st Century education. *12 Weeks, January - April	Online
ED 6010 Special Topics in Education Administration, Policy, Leadership, & Change (Elective)	Course description to follow. *6 Week Intensive, May – June	Online
ED 6270 Global Education (Elective)	This course examines the theory and practice of global education in 21 st Century contexts as developed in Canada and elsewhere. *6 Week Intensive, July – August	Online
ED 6170 Issues in Educational Leadership (Required)	This course examines current issues in leadership in 21 st Century contexts with a focus on authentic assessment. *12 Weeks, September - December	Online
