ED 611 Introduction to Research (Required)	This course develops an understanding of qualitative and quantitative research methodologies for 21 st Century teaching and learning. <i>*Six Week Intensive, July – August, 2019</i>	Online
ED 634 Special Topics: 21st Century Teaching and Learning (Elective)	Students investigate key topics related to 21 st Century Teaching and Learning. <i>*12 Weeks, September – December, 2019</i>	Online
ED 615 Educational Leadership (Required)	This course examines aspects of leadership that impact on schools and explores models of effective leadership in 21 st Century Contexts. <i>*12 Weeks, January – April, 2020</i>	Online
ED 626 Technology: Leadership in Learning (Elective)	Students examine and critique current research trends in information and communication technology with a focus on educational uses of digital technologies. <i>*Six Week Intensive, April – May, 2020</i>	Online
ED 618 Learning, Leadership and Reflective Practice (Required)	Students examine processes of reflective practice such as analytic problem-solving and self-assessment. Students research reflective practices that have made positive contributions to learning and leadership. <i>*Six Week Intensive, July – August, 2020</i>	Online
ED 619 Critical Pedagogy (Required)	This course examines historical, economic, political, cultural, and social contexts that are shaping 21 st Century education. <i>*12 Weeks, September – December, 2020</i>	Online
ED 627 Global Education (Elective)	This course examines the theory and practice of global education in 21 st Century contexts as developed in Canada and elsewhere. <i>*12 Weeks, January – April, 2021</i>	Online
ED 614 Theories of Research and Learning (Required)	This course familiarizes students with theories and principles of learning in 21 st Century contexts with a focus on student engagement. <i>*Six Week Intensive, April – May, 2021</i>	Online
ED 625 Curriculum: Leadership in Learning (Required)	This course examines theories of curriculum and assessment including exploration of project-based learning. <i>*Six Week Intensive, July – August, 2021</i>	Online
ED 617 Issues in Educational Leadership (Required)	This course examines current issues in leadership in 21 st Century contexts with a focus on authentic assessment. <i>*12 Weeks, September - December</i>	Online
