## TENTATIVE Program Schedule for July 2019 to June 2021: Convocation May 2022

<b>ED 611 Introduction to Research</b>	This course develops an understanding of qualitative and quantitative research methodologies for college teaching, learning, and leadership. <i>July 8-12 (8 am-4 pm), 2019</i>	<b>UPEI Campus</b>
<b>ED 615 Educational Leadership</b>	This course examines aspects of leadership that impact on schools and explores models of effective leadership in college contexts. <i>July 15-19 (8 am-4 pm), 2019</i>	<b>UPEI Campus</b>
<b>ED 629 Program Evaluation</b>	In this course, students study the various concepts and issues in program evaluation. Students research the literature on program evaluation to understand the tools and knowledge necessary for conducting an evaluation assessment. <i>September – December, 2019</i>	Online
<b>ED 614 Theories of Research and Learning</b>	This course familiarizes students with theories and principles of learning in college contexts with a focus on student engagement. <i>January – April, 2020</i>	Online
<b>ED 692 Higher Education Teaching (Elective)</b>	This course introduces the pedagogies, practices, and instructional alternatives that foster acquisition of the knowledge, skills, and attitudes critical to successful teaching at the post-secondary level. <i>May – June, 2020</i>	Online
<b>ED 601 Assessment of Adult Learners (Elective)</b>	This course examines formative and summative assessment methods suitable for adult learners. <i>July 8-12 (8 am-4 pm), 2020</i>	<b>UPEI Campus</b>
<b>ED 619 Critical Pedagogy</b>	This course examines historical, economic, political, cultural, and social contexts that are shaping college teaching, learning, and leadership. <i>July 15-19 (8 am-4 pm), 2020</i>	<b>UPEI Campus</b>
<b>ED 626 Technology: Leadership in Learning (Elective)</b>	Students examine and critique current research trends in information and communication technology with a focus on educational uses of digital technologies. <i>September – December, 2020</i>	Online
<b>ED 625 Curriculum: Leadership in Learning</b>	This course examines theories of curriculum and assessment including exploration of project-based learning. <i>January – April, 2021</i>	Online
<b>ED 617 Issues in Educational Leadership</b>	This course examines current issues in leadership in college contexts with a focus on authentic assessment. <i>May – June, 2021</i>	Online
