

## MASTER OF EDUCATION (MEd) IN LEARNING

### FOR ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY

This Master of Education cohort will focus on Education for Environmental Sustainability with educators who are working in a wide variety of contexts within and beyond schools. This cohort will examine theories, research, and practices concerning education for environmental sustainability, with a focus on problem-based learning, inquiry, and building an environmentally sustainable culture.

### SPECIAL FEATURES OF THIS COHORT

- Ten courses all focused on theories, research, and practices in education for environmental sustainability
- Seven courses online and three courses onsite in two UPEI Summer Institutes at the beginning and end of the program
- Competitive tuition fees
- Program completion in 25 months

### **ADMISSION CRITERIA**

An undergraduate or graduate degree from an approved university with an average of 70% or higher in the last 20 courses (60 credit hours). An applicant who lacks a degree, or an applicant who possesses a degree with an academic average under 70%, may be considered for admission under exceptional circumstances.
