Qualify for PEI Additional Designation in Inclusive Education

This Master of Education (MEd) Cohort is for you if you are interested in inclusive education and differentiated instruction. Students in this cohort learn about educational scholarship, theories, research, and practices for inclusive education in diverse contexts.

Included in this ten-course program are the courses that qualify PEI school-based teachers for the Additional Designation in Inclusive Education.

SPECIAL FEATURES OF THIS COHORT

- Ten courses focused on theories, research, and practices in inclusive education and differentiated instruction within or outside schools
- Six courses online; four courses onsite in two UPEI Summer Institutes
- Competitive tuition fees
- Program completion in 24 months

ADMISSION CRITERIA

An undergraduate or graduate degree from an approved university with an average of 70% or higher in the last 20 courses (60 credit hours). An applicant who lacks a degree, or an applicant who possesses a degree with an academic average under 70%, may be considered for admission under exceptional circumstances.

All documents are to be sent to the Office of the Registrar. Please indicate on your application form and in your personal statement that you are applying to this special cohort. We will accept applications until the cohort is full.
