ED 6110 Introduction to Research (Required)	This course develops an understanding of qualitative and quantitative research methodologies with a focus on inclusive education. <i>*One Week Intensive - July, 2020</i>	UPEI Campus
ED 6150 Educational Leadership (Required)	This course examines aspects of leadership that impact on schools and explores models of effective leadership in Special Education. (PEI AD AREA 4 – Additional Areas; Leadership in Special Education) <i>*One Week Intensive - July, 2020</i>	UPEI Campus
ED 6160 Action Research In Education (Required)	Students examine educational practices using action research strategies. Students examine research topic selection, methodology, data collection and analysis, and interpretation of results. This process of inquiry reinforces reflective practice. <i>*12 Weeks - September – December, 2020</i>	Online
ED 6010 Special Topics in Mental health (Elective) OR	Course description to follow. <i>*12 Weeks - January – April, 2021</i>	Online
ED 6225 Assessment for Students with Learning Challenges (Elective)	In this course, students will be introduced to the overall process & considerations involved with the formal individualized educational assessment of students (Level B assessment) <i>*12 Weeks - January – April, 2021</i>	UPEI Campus
ED 6190 Critical Pedagogy (Required)	This course examines historical, economic, political, cultural, and social contexts that are shaping inclusive education. <i>*6 Week Intensive – May – June, 2021</i>	Online
ED6250 Curriculum: Leadership in Learning (Required)	This course examines aspects of leadership that impact on schools and explores models of effective leadership for inclusive education. <i>*One Week Intensive - July, 2021</i>	UPEI Campus
ED 6140 Theories of Research and Learning (Required)	This course supports students in examining theories and principles of research and learning with a focus on inclusive education. <i>*One Week Intensive - July, 2021</i>	UPEI Campus
ED 6020 Special Topics: Inclusive Education and Diverse Learners (Elective)	Students will examine and critique dominant views informing schooling policies and practices regarding current issues related to diversity and equity in learning environments. <i>*12 Weeks - September – December, 2021</i>	Online
ED-6030 Inclusive Practices for Diverse Learners (Elective)	This course involves the examination of theoretical and practical aspects regarding inclusive strategies and practices for diverse learners in educational settings. <i>*12 Weeks - January – April, 2022</i>	Online
ED 617 Issues in Educational Leadership (Required)	This course examines current issues in educational leadership with a focus on collaborative practice. (PEI AD AREA 3 – Collaborative Practice) <i>*Six Week Intensive – May – June, 2022</i>	Online



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
