

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## Focus on MATHEMATICS EDUCATION

Interested in transforming how mathematics is taught? The UPEI Master of Education (MEd) in Leadership in Learning has a new cohort focused on Mathematics Education for teachers at any level from Kindergarten to Grade 12.

### SPECIAL FEATURES OF THIS COHORT

- Ten courses all focused on mathematics education
- Six courses online and four courses onsite in two UPEI Summer Institutes
- ED 619 Critical Pedagogy course uses a modular design to cover key areas of mathematics education (with option to substitute one ED 619 module with a trip to the New York Mathematics Museum at additional cost)
- Competitive tuition fees
- Program completion in 24 months

### **ADMISSION CRITERIA**

An undergraduate or graduate degree from an approved university with an average of 70% or higher in the last 20 courses (60 credit hours). An applicant who lacks a degree, or an applicant who possesses a degree with an academic average under 70%, may be considered for admission under exceptional circumstances.
