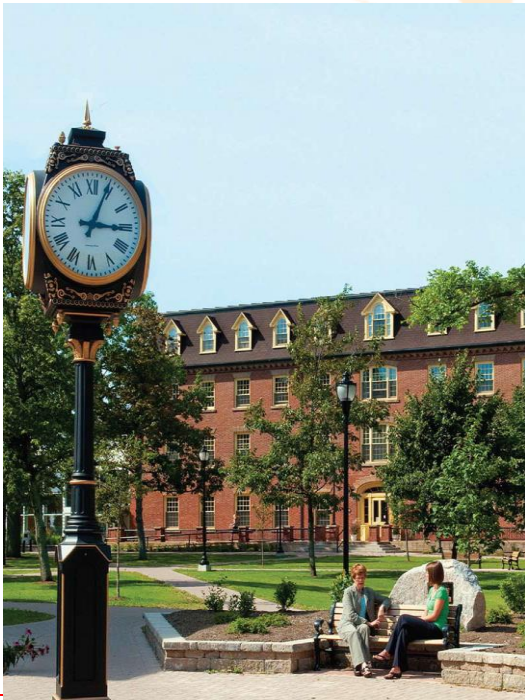

FALL 2015 – Sept 8 – Dec 4

ED695 Graduate Seminar Tuesdays 9:00-12:00am	Students attend and present seminars on topics in their discipline, are evaluated on their seminars, and provide constructive criticism for other student seminars.
ED 611 Introduction To Research Methods In Education Thursdays 5:00-8:00pm	Students are introduced to a variety of methods that are appropriate for conducting research in diverse settings based on critical analysis of current studies reported in educational literature.
Ed 625 Curriculum: Leadership In Learning Wednesdays 5:00-8:00pm	Students examine research into recent curriculum developments which are based on principles of integration, resource-based learning, and holistic learning, and which require the use of alternative assessment approaches.

WINTER 2016 – Jan 4 – Apr 8

ED 627 Global Education Wednesdays 5:00-8:00pm	Students examine the theory and practice of global education as it has developed in Canada and elsewhere.
ED 615 Educational Leadership Tuesdays 5:00-8:00pm	Students examine the field of educational leadership beyond the role of the school administrator and focus upon the development of educators as leaders.
Ed614 Theories Of Research And Learning Thursdays 1:00-4:00pm	Students address the role of theory in educational research. The aim is to familiarize graduate students with various theoretical frameworks including theories and principles of learning.

SPRING/SUMMER INSTITUTE Late June–August 2016

ED619 Critical Pedagogy Schedule TBD	Students explore ways in which teachers can systematically examine their own classroom practices. Emphasis is placed on inquiries that develop reflective practice.
ED 628 International Education and Development Schedule TBD	Students examine how education is organized and practiced with global perspectives that differ between countries in relationship to their cultural, economic, and social development directions.

FALL 2016

Ed616 Action Research In Education Schedule TBD	Students examine educational practices using action research strategies. Students examine research topic selection, methodology, data collection and analysis, and interpretation of results. This process of inquiry reinforces reflective practice.
ED 601 Workplace Learning and Leadership Schedule TBD	Through experiential learning in diverse educational settings, students will develop awareness of organizational cultures, observe leadership practices, and enhance cross-cultural communication skills.
