#### **ADMISSION CRITERIA**

- An undergraduate or graduate degree from an approved university with an average of 70% or higher in the last 20 courses (60 credit hours). An applicant who lacks a degree, or an applicant who possesses a degree with an academic average under 70%, may be considered for admission under exceptional circumstances.
- Two years of relevant professional experience (an asset for admission and interpreted flexibly).


