

International Applicant Information

International applicants are required to hold a baccalaureate degree in nursing that is equivalent to Canadian baccalaureate nursing programs. Your degree must be assessed by a national organization, as a component of the application process to the MN Program. In the event that you are interested in seeking registration in Canada, please visit the National Nursing Assessment Service (NNAS) to view the application processes (www.nnas.ca).

You will be required to register with our professional organization, the College of Registered Nurses of PEI (CRNPEI), upon being accepted to the program. This means that you must be eligible for registration by writing the international NCLEX RN exam prior to acceptance.
