
Faculty of Education Master of Education Special Cohort for College Educators and Leaders



UPEI, in partnership with Holland College, will offer a Master of Education (MEd) in Leadership in Learning with a focus on College Leadership - a special cohort for college educators, leaders and aspiring leaders. This is round four of this customized program.

FEATURES OF THIS SPECIAL COHORT

- 10 courses (6 online, 4 face-to-face in summer institutes in beautiful Charlottetown).
- All students in the cohort will be college educators, leaders and aspiring leaders.
- Instructors will be nationally recognized educational leaders with experience in university and college settings.
- Program completion within 30 months.
- Starting September 2015.
