

The Statement of Intent

A statement of intent must be included in the student's application for the UPEI PhD program in Educational Studies. The statement of intent should not exceed 10 single spaced pages (Times New Roman 12-point font, margins no less than one inch).

The statement of intent should detail the proposed area of dissertation research, projected timeline for completion of the program, career goals, and reasons for seeking admission to UPEI's PhD program in Educational Studies, including how the proposed PhD program relates to the applicant's graduate studies and to his or her research and professional experiences.

Students should contact the Coordinator of Graduate Studies to discuss the application and to seek advice about demonstrating the fit between a potential supervisor(s) and the student's research interests for the dissertation. Admission will only be offered to qualified applicants whose research interests are similar to the scope of expertise of a potential supervisor(s) in the Faculty of Education at UPEI. Applicants should indicate in the statement of intent whether or not they have had discussions with a potential faculty advisor.
