- ❑ **D.A. Murchison Memorial Award in Music**: for a returning Music student who is in good academic standing and has displayed extraordinary volunteerism and leadership on campus and in the greater community
- ❑ **Daniel St. Amand Memorial Music Award**: for a Music student in any year of study who is in financial need
- ❑ **Dr. Elaine Harrison Award**: for a returning student who is talented and working toward an Arts or Music degree, and has a demonstrated financial need

- ❑ **Marilyn MacDonald Memorial Nursing Award:** for a third or fourth year full-time Nursing student at UPEI in financial need who has shown exceptional mentorship, leadership skills, and demonstrated dedication to compassionate care; *separate application required*

- ❑ **Robert J. Connaughton Sr. Memorial Award**: for a student athlete in financial need, with preference given in the following order: on varsity football team (HC or UPEI); on UPEI Track and Field team; or on UPEI Hockey team
- Robert 'Rocky' Paquet Memorial Award**: for a returning student who has volunteered in the university or broader community through activities and volunteerism and loves music and animals; *separate application required*
- Roderick Stirling MacDonald Scholarships**: for full time students at UPEI (Graduate or Undergraduate, 35 awards annually) with an 85% or greater in every course average, and demonstrates an interest in enhancing our local and global communities; *separate application required*
- The Rotary Club of Charlottetown Student Accessibility Award**: for a UPEI student with a documented disability who has overcome barriers in their educational pursuits and demonstrated leadership, volunteerism and community service; *separate application required*
