EXECUTIVE MBA AWARD SCHOLARSHIPS

DESCRIPTION

Executive MBA Award Scholarships are intended to encourage and support strong academic performance and leadership in the Executive MBA (EMBA) Program. The number and value of these awards varies, depending on annual funding levels. Both first- and second-year EMBA students are eligible to apply.

ELIEGIBLITY CRITERIA

Scholarship applicants must meet the following eligibility criteria to be considered for an award scholarship:

- Applicants must be enrolled in the EMBA Program
- Applicants must complete and submit the scholarship application package
- Preference will be given to candidates who have not received employer support and/or other graduate student awards that, combined, exceed 50% of the Program's tuition and fees

SELECTION CRITERIA

The Scholarship Committee will consider the applicant's previous and current academic record (including completed EMBA Courses), professional accomplishments, and leadership inside and outside the classroom. The Committee will also evaluate the applicant's scholarship essay and, in some cases, may conduct an interview.

APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCEDURES

- Applicants are required to complete and submit the attached scholarship application form
- Applicants must also prepare and submit a short essay (maximum of 500 words). The essay should outline why the applicant believes they should receive an EMBA award scholarship, how they have exhibited leadership in the EMBA Program and beyond, how they have benefited from the Program thus far, and how their involvement and learning through the Program will further support their leadership. Applicants are encouraged to review the selection criteria and address these points within their letter of interest in a creative and persuasive manner.
- Selection will be based on the confidence of the committee that the chosen applicants will continue to display exceptional leadership and be actively engaged in the EMBA Program. In some cases, the selection committee may conduct interviews with applicants.
