Engineers PEI Entrance Scholarships: Glenda MacKinnon-Peters Engineering Scholarship & Father Charlie MacDonald Engineering Scholarship

DESCRIPTION

These annual scholarships and awards were established at the University of Prince Edward Island in 1994 by the Association of Professional Engineers of Prince Edward Island (APEPEI), now known as Engineers PEI. The scholarships are named after distinguished PEI engineers who were active and instrumental members in the Association of Professional Engineers. The establishment of a PEI Branch of the Engineering Institute of Canada (E.I.C.) in 1952 brought together a group of engineers. Eventually, this group was responsible for the formation of the Association of Professional Engineers of Prince Edward Island. At a meeting of the E.I.C. Branch in October 1954, a decision was taken to proceed with the setting up of A.P.E.P.E.I. and the P.E.I. Engineering Profession Act was passed and given Royal assent on March 18, 1955. The Association opened its first permanent office in Charlottetown in 1989.

Over the lifetime of the Association, both the volume and value of engineering work undertaken on the Island have increased substantially and this is reflected in the increase in the number of engineers practicing in PEI. Engineers PEI have generously supported numerous awards for several years. In 2014 they decided to increase their annual gift, in order to support eight annually funded awards and scholarships for UPEI students.

CRITERIA

The Glenda MacKinnon-Peters and Father Charles MacDonald Engineering Scholarships will be awarded to two well-rounded students (as evidenced by a letter of reference from a nonfamily individual) entering the first year of the UPEI Sustainable Design Engineering degree program, and who graduated from a Prince Edward Island high school.
