### DESCRIPTION

These scholarships are provided by the Friends of UPEI Calgary who began an annual fundraising dinner and auction in 1998. Founder and chair, Bill LeClair, and numerous volunteers organize this event which is held each year on the first Saturday in November in Calgary, Alberta.

### **CRITERIA**

Each year, numerous scholarships will be offered to students both **entering** and **returning** to full time undergraduate program study at UPEI. These scholarships will be granted to students from Alberta, with preference given to students from Calgary. Students are eligible to receive the award for a maximum of four years.

#### AWARD VALUE

The scholarship values for each recipient of the general Friends of UPEI Calgary Scholarships will be determined by the Friends of UPEI Calgary Committee.

## **APPLICATION PROCESS (Deadline: May 1)**

All students (**entrance** and **returning**) must apply for a Friends of UPEI Calgary Scholarship by May 1 of the preceding awarding academic year. This will include a completed application form and personal statement.
