## Harry W. MacLauchlan Scholarships in Entrepreneurial Leadership

### **DESCRIPTION**

This scholarship program was established at the University of Prince Edward Island by Marjorie MacLauchlan and family, to honour the memory of Harry W. MacLauchlan (1926 - 2002) who combined entrepreneurial initiative, work ethic, business judgment and people skills, with a deep commitment of his family, community and province.

It is the family's wish that these scholarships be awarded to students in their third and fourth years of study rather than to incoming students in order to provide them with an opportunity to have demonstrated their entrepreneurial inclinations as well as to provide professors an opportunity to get to know the students and promote these scholarships to those students who have displayed entrepreneurial inclinations.

These renewable scholarships are intended to encourage and support future generations or entrepreneurial and community leaders on Prince Edward Island.

#### **CRITERIA**

Up to three (3) scholarships available annually for third year UPEI students enrolled in full-time undergraduate studies, based on the following eligibility criteria for applicants:

- Has demonstrated entrepreneurial initiative through past or current experience
- Has plans to undertake an entrepreneurial career on Prince Edward Island,
- Achieved an average of 75% or greater in each of their first two years at UPEI

To apply for <u>renewal for fourth year</u>, recipients must have achieved academic standing of 75% or greater in their previous year of study, and provide an update report on the status of their business venture by **July 15** to be reviewed by the adjudicating committee.

Please submit all required material by the posted deadline in order to be considered.
