DESCRIPTION

This award was established by Elise Hynes in memory of her late husband to recognize his deep commitment to the advancement of Aboriginal people and to recognize those students who distinguish themselves through leadership, perseverance and academic accomplishment.

CRITERIA

Beginning in the academic year 2012/13, **one entrance award** will be granted to an Aboriginal student entering UPEI in full-time undergraduate studies who is positively and actively involved in their community, and who has a high school academic record that reflects his/her perseverance to studies.

AWARD VALUE

\$1000

ELIGIBILITY AND SELECTION CRITERIA

Applicants must:

- be accepted into an undergraduate program at UPEI;
- complete the formal application form;
- have a demonstrated involvement in community service;
- be in good academic standing;
- include a resume and an explanation of how they meet the criteria; and
- provide at least one letter of reference that attests to the applicant's academic achievement and leadership qualities.
