CRITERIA

Preference will be given to students who have been accepted into a professional school or program in the following order: Audiology, Medicine, or research in the medical field. In the event of two or more students qualifying for consideration in the same field, and said field if the first to be considered in the preferences above, academic achievement and financial need will be the defining factors.
