Parks and People Association Scholarships

DESCRIPTION

Founded in 1981, Parks and People Association Inc. (the Association) is a non-profit, charitable organization that promotes awareness, appreciation and conservation of the National Park and National Historic Sites of Prince Edward Island. Its members have supported conservation initiatives, created fun recreational opportunities and celebrated Prince Edward Island's cultural and natural heritage. These activities have been directly supported by proceeds from Parks and People retail outlets in Cavendish – Nature Store, Green Gables – Butter Churn Café, Greenwich Interpretation Centre – Boutique, and Province House – Gift Shop.

In 2017 the directors of the Association recognized that the life of the Association was coming to an end with a reduced membership base and much of what they had set out to do have been achieved. The Association then decided to use the remaining funds they had raised to support scholarships at the University of Prince Edward Island and Holland College. This has been achieved at UPEI through the establishment of the Parks and People Association Scholarships Endowment. This endowed fund will provide support in perpetuity to UPEI students who have an expressed interest in the environment and sustainable design.

CRITERIA

Granted to returning UPEI students who are normally resident in Canada, have a demonstrated interest in protecting the Island environment through the development of sustainable design initiatives, and are in the Faculty of Sustainable Design Engineering.
