

Rogers-Cairns Scholarship Application Form

The Rogers-Cairns Scholarship was established through the generosity of Mary Elizabeth Roger Cairns (1906 - 1986). Mrs. Cairns was born in Rossland, British Columbia, of Prince Edward Island stock. After working as a registered nurse in Vancouver and Montreal she moved to Freetown, P.E.I. where she married R. Louis Cairns in 1946. With the exception of her last years, she lived the remainder of her life in Freetown, sharing the work of a home and farm, and generously contributing time and talent to her community and to the Freetown United Church.

The criteria for awarding this scholarship, as set out in Mrs. Cairns' will, are as follows:

1. At the time of application applicants must intend to register during the following year for full-time studies at the University of Prince Edward Island at the third or fourth-year level.
2. Applicants must be abstainers from tobacco, alcohol, and non-medicinal drugs.
3. In granting scholarships, priority will be assigned in the following order:
 - A. Applicants who are recognized by their denominations as candidates or intended candidates for the ministry or other full-time church work in Protestant denominations (United Church, Presbyterian, Baptist).
 - B. Applicants who are recognized by their denomination as candidates or intended candidates for the clergy or other full-time church work in the Roman Catholic Church.
 - C. Applicants who are intending to enter Medicine, Dentistry, or Nursing.
 - D. Applicants will be evaluated on the basis of academic standing, integrity, and character.

Students may apply for the Rogers-Cairns Scholarship by completing the attached application form. In addition, applicants must arrange for a recommendation to be submitted that evaluates the applicant in terms of the criteria listed above. At the applicant's option, either one or two recommendations may be submitted. Those submitting recommendations must be unrelated to the applicant, and must have known the applicant in the context of an educational institution, religious organization, workplace, or volunteer organization. In the case of the applicants who are candidates for clergy or full-time church work, at least one recommendation must be submitted by a minister or priest of the denomination for which the applicant is an intended candidate.

Students may apply during their second year for support during their third year, or during their third year for support during their fourth year. Scholarships granted for third year studies will be renewed for a fourth year following satisfactory academic performance in the third year.

Application forms may be obtained at the UPEI Registrar's Office. Selection of successful applicants is made by the Board of Trustees of Trinity United Church, Charlottetown.

In the case of requests for renewal, scholarship recipients must inform Trinity Church by letter of their intention to return to full-time studies at UPEI and arrange to have transcripts of their third-year academic performance forwarded to Trinity Church.
