The University uses the European Transfer Credit System (ECTS) where 6 ECTS is equivalent to 1 UPEI course. A full study load per semester is 30 ECTS. For more information on this system, see:

English Language Requirements

Although Aalto University does not require any official test record of English like TOEFL or IELTS, the University expects students to be proficient in English both in writing and in communicating in the classroom in order to be able to fulfill the course assignments, equivalent to IELTS 6,5 (total) or TOEFL 92 (total).

Housing

Since Aalto University does not offer on-campus accommodation, most exchange students find accommodation through student housing organizations such as HOAS (Foundation for Student Housing in the Helsinki Region) and AYY (Aalto University Student Union). These organizations have reserved furnished accommodation for exchange students. The typical type of accommodation is a furnished flat, where bedrooms are private, but the kitchen and bathroom are shared with 3-5 other students. As accommodation cannot be guaranteed for everybody, it is important to apply as early as possible.

Visa and Travel Information

Canadian citizens are required to obtain a student visa if they will be staying in Finland for over 90 days. It is recommended that you apply for a visa well in advance before booking your flight. You must be accepted to study at Aalto University before applying for your student visa.

Insurance

Health insurance is a **mandatory requirement** for obtaining a residence permit (non-EU/EEA citizens) for studies lasting more than 90 days. Orientation for exchange students will be organized before the start of each term. Before your arrival, Aalto will send you a travel plan form asking for detailed information on your arrival. This is extremely important so that your tutor will know when to meet you at the airport.
