Visa and Travel Information

Canadian citizens must obtain a student visa if they intend to study at Universidad de Burgos. It is recommended that you apply for a visa well in advance before booking your flight. Before coming to Spain, non-EU citizens must obtain private medical insurance covering medical assistance and hospitalization, including repatriation cover that will be valid during their time abroad. Liability insurance is not necessary.
