Hawk University uses the ECT (European Transfer Credit) system, where 6 ECTS is equivalent to 1 UPEI course. A full course load per semester is about 30 ECTS.

Grading is on a scale of 5.0 (minimum) to 1.0 (maximum) with 4.0 as the minimum passing grade. 2.5 is considered a good grade.

Accommodation

Exchange students may indicate on the application form if they are seeking an accommodation offer and whether they prefer accommodation in a dormitory or a shared flat. The International Office will try to find a room in the preferred category at a reasonable price.

Visa and Travel Information
