Courses

Seinan Gakuin University offers a range of Japanese language and culture courses to exchange students. The University also allows exchange students to take Special Topic / Independent Study courses. The Special Topic program allows exchange students to take regular university courses so long as they can understand the language of instruction (although most are taught in Japanese, there are several courses taught in English).
