Accommodation

Zuyd University provides on-campus housing for exchange students. Two options are available:

Avantgarde Residence

Furnished rooms with wall-to-wall carpet, curtains, lighting, single bed, mattress, duvet and pillow, table and chair. Bed linen is not included. Each room has a wardrobe, and an ensuite shower and toilet. There is a shared common room, and each of the floors has a shared kitchen, laundry room and dining room. The residence has a terrace, parking lot and secure bicycle shed. Rent is \in 350 per month and deposit is \notin 500. These prices include all services and wireless internet.

M-Building, Brouwersweg

Student Housing SSH offers fully furnished single rooms for $\notin 450 \cdot \notin 525$ per month, shared rooms are available for $\notin 370 \cdot \notin 390$ per person. The residence has shared kitchens, showers and living rooms on each floor, and residents have access to tennis and basketball courts. Deposit is 1.5 of monthly rent paid in advance and a reservation fee of $\notin 75$.
