

2025-2026 Economics Major Checklist

It is important to consult the UPEI calendar for the general requirements for the Bachelor of Arts.

The major in economics requires the following courses (from the UPEI calendar):

Economics

- 1010 - Introductory Microeconomics
- 1020 - Introductory Macroeconomics
- 2030 - Intermediate Microeconomics I
- 2040 - Intermediate Macroeconomics I
- 2050 - Intermediate Microeconomics II
- 2060 - Intermediate Macroeconomics II
- 3030 - Economic Methodology
- 3080 - Introduction to Econometrics

Plus:

Six (6) additional elective courses in economics, at least three of which must be at the 3000 or 4000 level.

Mathematics

- 1110 - Finite Mathematics
- 1910 - Single Variable Calculus I

Statistics

- 1910 - Introduction to Probability and Statistics

In addition, students planning on Graduate Studies (in Economics) should plan on taking Mathematical Economics (EC 3070), Advanced Microeconomics (EC 4030), and Advanced Macroeconomics (EC 4030). It is important to note that all of these courses partially satisfy the elective requirements for the major listed above.

When planning courses, students need to note the pre-requisite structure of the required courses:
