

Requirements for a joint Major in Sociology/Anthropology

Required

Sociology 1010 and Anthropology 1050

Six (6) core courses (Sociology 3010, Sociology 3020, Sociology 3320, Anthropology 3320, Anthropology 3610, and EITHER Sociology 3310 OR Anthropology 3210)

Nine electives (details provided below)

Required Introductory Courses

Sociology 1010

Anthropology 1050

Combined average = 60%

CORE COURSES

Sociology 3010

Sociology 3020

Sociology 3320

Anthropology 3320

Anthropology 3610

EITHER Sociology 3310

OR Anthropology 3210

Nine (9) electives, of which

Two (2) must be area courses

Two (2) must be 2000-, 3000-, or 4000-level courses in Sociology/Anthropology

Four (4) must be 3000- or 4000-level courses

One (1) must be any Anthropology, Sociology or Sociology/Anthropology course at the 2000-, 3000-, or 4000-level

PLEASE NOTE

- Prospective Majors: Minimum combined average of 60% in Sociology 1010 and Anthropology 1050
- Prospective Majors: Minimum combined average of 65% in four (4) 2000-level (and above) Anthropology, Sociology, or Sociology/Anthropology courses
- Recommended: Apply for Major at end of second year/beginning of third year
- Strongly recommended: Take 2000-level courses in second year
