- 1. **Letter of Reference** from your home institution confirming that you are in good academic standing and eligible to enter your final year of veterinary medicine program (clinical training year);
- 2. Completed and signed Invitee Access Agreement form for student visitors;
- Proof of valid personal medical insurance while in Canada (if applying from outside of Canada);
- 4. Proof of pre-exposure **rabies immunization** in the past two years with a human diploid vaccine or a satisfactory rabies titre;
- 5. Proof of English proficiency (if applying outside of North America);

6. Copy of academic transcript from your home institution (in English, for students applying from non-accredited institutions) can be unofficial
