PLEASE NOTE:

Fees for AVC Vet Camp are \$534.50 CAD (plus 15%HST) and include educational materials, field trips, labs, lunches, special activities, a backpack, and a souvenir scrub top. Fees do not include overnight accommodations; campers are required to secure their own housing with adult supervision. Payment is not required until campers have been chosen and attendance confirmed. If applying by mail, you will receive an email indicating that we have received your application. If applying online, after pressing "submit," you will see a message confirming that your application has been received. You will also receive a copy of the completed online application by email. **The deadline for receipt of applications is Friday, March 18, 2022**. You will be notified by email the week of April 4–8, 2022, if you have or have not been chosen to attend.
