Music Degree Options

A student who chooses a degree program in music at UPEI has 3 different degree options.

- <u>Bachelor of Music</u> focus on performance, theory, composition, or history
- <u>Bachelor of Music Education</u> become a teacher anywhere in Canada with our five-year single-degree program
- <u>Bachelor of Arts with a Major in Music</u> study music within a general arts curriculum
