# Top Transferable Skills

**Problem-Solving:** Connect ideas to broad concepts, define problems, weigh alternatives, address opposing viewpoints, apply logic, identify and evaluate results and investigate alternatives to provide solutions.

**Communication:** Articulate abstract complicated concepts, present alternative viewpoints, and write persuasively by demonstration of effective reasoning.
