The ideal candidate will have demonstrated excellence in his/her chosen field and in overall service to the community at large. He/she will have a strong public presence and profile. Current UPEI employees or students are not eligible.

Nominations should include the nominee's city/town and province of residence, profession, relationship to UPEI and the wider PEI community, and involvement in the private and/or public sector, as well as biographical information that would assist the selection committee.
