

## Dutch Inn FAQ's

Last update October 7<sup>th</sup> 2019

Here are some answers to frequently asked questions about the Dutch Inn:

The Dutch Inn will be rented solely to UPEI students from Sept - April. It will be a fantastic community and a great place to meet people.

**You are required to be 18 years old to reside at the Dutch Inn.**

**When can I move in?** September 1<sup>st</sup> for first semester and January 2<sup>nd</sup> for second semester are the dates you can go to the Dutch Inn and start moving in. **There will be no early move-ins.**

If you arrive prior to September 1<sup>st</sup> or January 2<sup>nd</sup>, you can contact Samantha at Canada's Best Value Charlottetown [canadasbestvaluecharlottetown@gmail.com](mailto:canadasbestvaluecharlottetown@gmail.com) 902-892-2481 and ask for the UPEI group nightly rate.

**Transportation: How will I get to class?** There is a bus that stops near the Inn (*York Point Road Bus Shelter*) and goes straight to UPEI (*UPEI Bus Shelter*). The cost is free for full-time students and the travel time is approximately 5 minutes. You can see the bus schedule attached to this document or on their website: <https://t3transit.ca/>. There have been night time runs added specifically for the Dutch Inn residents and those drop you at the front door of the hotel.

**Food: What options do I have?** You can purchase breakfast at the Dutch Inn any day for \$5 per day (plus applicable taxes). They are also serving daily meals for under \$10. You can also purchase a meal plan on campus and pay for it through your student account. Two bedroom apartments in the Dutch Inn have a kitchenette. Double and single rooms include a mini-fridge and microwave.

**Double rooms:** These are shared with a roommate - if you have roommate requests, please let Off Campus Housing know. Please do not change rooms without going through our office.

**What if I want a single room?** Please let me know and a waiting list will be created for these. Currently there are none available.

**What if I still want to be on campus?** Please contact Residence Services [residence@upei.ca](mailto:residence@upei.ca) and you will be added to a waiting list for buildings on campus. You will be notified if a space becomes available. In the meantime, follow the steps to confirm your offer so that you have somewhere to live. **Please secure housing before leaving your home country/province.**

**How long is the agreement for?:** September 2019-April 2020.  
Or January 2020-April 2020.

**What about Holidays?:** You will be able to stay in your room over Christmas and any other holiday periods between September 1 and April 30 at no additional cost.

### What do I need to do next?

2. Pay a damage deposit to secure your room

*Single Room:* Double bed, mini-fridge, microwave, couch, TV: *Price:* \$3000 per semester
