


#### **REGIONAL CONTEXT**

Atlantic universities collectively experienced a year-over-year decline in total, undergraduate (both full-time and part-time), and full-time first-year first-entry student enrolments; but experienced growth in numbers of graduate students, full-time visa students, and new transfer students. UPEI outperformed the regional trend for graduate student and international student enrolments. This places UPEI slightly above the Maritime average and just slightly below the Atlantic average for enrolment changes as compared to 2014.

#### CHANGE IN TOTAL ENROLMENT RELATIVE TO THE LEVEL IN 2010






