

REGIONAL CONTEXT

Overall, enrolment in Atlantic Canadian universities remained stable over 2016–2017. Taken together, full- and part-time undergraduate and graduate student enrolment in the region declined by 0.3% in the fall of 2017. However, full- and part-time graduate student enrolment increased by 1.4%, and international student enrolment by 4.3% year-over-year. Also, full-time first-year student enrolment increased overall by 0.2%. UPEI continued to outperform the regional trend in 2017, with an overall increase of 2.6% in student population.


AAU ENROLMENT SURVEY

RELATIVE TO THE LEVEL IN 2007






INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ORIGIN BY COUNTRY/ REGION/CONTINENT (OCTOBER 2, 2017)
