

REGIONAL CONTEXT


The AAU's regional enrolment survey illustrates that from 2008–2018, UPEI's total student enrolment increased by 10 per cent, while that of the overall Atlantic region (less UPEI) went up by 2.3 per cent. The number of full-time first-year first-entry students increased by 3.3 per cent for UPEI but decreased by 5 per cent in the region in this category. The AAU data indicates that from 2008–2018, UPEI outperformed other universities in the Atlantic region in total enrolment, total undergraduate and graduate enrolment, full-time visa student growth, full-time first-year first-entry student growth, and new transfer students.

CHANGE IN TOTAL ENROLMENT RELATIVE TO THE LEVEL IN 2008





INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ORIGIN BY COUNTRY/ REGION/CONTINENT (OCTOBER 1, 2018)




