

REGIONAL CONTEXT


Because of the global COVID-19 pandemic, UPEI, like many universities in the country, moved to a hybrid model of primarily online teaching and limited in-person teaching. The AAU survey of preliminary enrolments in 2020–2021 indicates that full-time student enrolment (undergraduate and graduate) decreased by 1.3 per cent and international students by 6.6 per cent at universities in the Atlantic region. AAU attributes these regional declines to the uncertainty caused by the pandemic. While subject to the same uncertainty, UPEI recorded an increase of 4.4 per cent in overall enrolment. An increase of 5.5 per cent in undergraduate students balanced out a decrease of 5.0 per cent in graduate student enrolment. International enrolment increased by 3.2 per cent although some students were not able to physically come to UPEI for the fall semester. UPEI continues to outpace regional growth over the 10-year period in overall undergraduate, graduate, and international

CHANGE IN TOTAL ENROLMENT * RELATIVE TO THE LEVEL IN 2010







INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ORIGIN BY COUNTRY/REGION/CONTINENT (OCTOBER 1, 2020)


