Certificate in Case Management



Case Management is a process used by professionals to help their clients find and address issues that are preventing them from achieving their goals. Case managers work collaboratively with all available resources to assess, plan, facilitate, and advocate for and on behalf of their clients. Through this process, case managers work to ensure that clients and their families receive positive, prompt, and cost-effective outcomes.

The Certificate in Case Management, developed by experienced professionals in collaboration with industry experts, explores the case management process and the skills necessary to manage client cases. The program will equip participants with the essential knowledge, skills, and confidence to meet the diverse needs of clients with special and complex needs while maximizing program efficiencies.

The Certificate in Case Management is a comprehensive introduction to case management for those who wish to take formal training. The program includes both case management theory and evidence-based skills development.

Certificate in Case Management (Specialization in Health Care)

- The ultimate goal of care coordination is to facilitate the appropriate delivery of healthcare services



Certificate in Collaborative Leadership

The Certificate in Collaborative Leadership is designed to provide exceptional professional development that keeps in mind their position's demanding nature, in terms of time requirements, structure, and activities.

After completing the Certificate in Collaborative Leadership, participants will have the knowledge and abilities to make a fundamental change to their organization to improve the work environment, morale, and productivity, and be able to influence others with enhanced inspiration, promotion, and engagement skills. This Certificate will make a major difference for participants, and by extension, their organization.

Certificate in Project Management



Project management is a core competency in our rapidly changing environment. The Certificate in Project Management introduces participants to the fundamentals of project management and discusses and dissects topics such as what is a project, what defines success, management of stakeholders, communication, leadership, project lifecycles, risk, budgets, and schedules. This Certificate program emphasizes agile and change management skills which are important in today's environment.

At the completion of this Certificate program, participants will have the knowledge and skills to plan, manage and complete a project of any size.

Topics include:

- o Project management fundamentals
- o Project Leadership
- o Project communication
- o Change management
- o Agile project management
- o Project start-up, planning and completion



Certificate in Mental Health Case Work

Many, if not most, of the social issues affecting our communities are related to mental health. By addressing mental health issues, groups and organizations can make a major difference in the lives of their clients and their families. However, in many areas in Canada, the people tasked with working with people suffering from mental health issues have little formal training in the area, becoming quickly overwhelmed with the casework surrounding their positions, and often end up with their mental health suffering as well.

The Certificate in Mental Health Case Work is designed to give practical and functional information, as well as effective methods and strategies, to deal with the casework surrounding clients with mental health struggles. By the end of the five-day Certificate, participants will be better equipped to handle clients and their issues, help prevent an escalation in mental health issues for those clients, as well as better handle the stresses of the job and help lessen the mental health burden on themselves.

Topics include:

- o Conflict resolution and de-escalation
- Anxiety and depression
- o Impacts of abuse and trauma
- Trauma-informed care and working with vulnerable clients
- o Suicide alertness and response
- o Case management
- Self-compassion and care
