REGIONAL CONTEXT

The Association of Atlantic Universities (AAU) reported in its 2025–2026 Survey of Preliminary Enrolments, published in October 2025, that overall enrolments in the region have declined by 4.4 per cent over the same time last year. The AAU also reported that enrolments of full-time international students across Atlantic universities declined by almost 28 per cent year-over-year due primarily to federal government policies affecting the recruitment of those students to the region.


Like most universities in Atlantic Canada, UPEI is not immune to these trends: total enrolment declined by 2.9 per cent, and international enrolment by 14.1 per cent.

However, when compared to other universities in the region, UPEI has done reasonably well overall. Full-time enrolment declined by 2.3 per cent at UPEI, compared to a 5.3 per cent decrease in the total Atlantic region. Full-time international enrolment decreased by 14.2 per cent compared to a 27.7 per cent decrease in the total Atlantic region. And total domestic enrolment at UPEI rose by 2.7 per cent.


Like all post-secondary institutions in Canada, UPEI is concerned about declining enrolment. The University is developing a strategic enrolment management plan to achieve and maintain optimal enrolment, recruitment, retention, and graduate rates—a roadmap for student success and the long-term success and sustainability of the University.






2025 STUDENT ORIGIN

(OCTOBER 1, 2025)




International students attending UPEI in 2025 come from 97 countries/regions. Students from
