

H. WADE MACLAUCHLAN RAISED EXPECTATIONS AWARDS

DESCRIPTION

Under the leadership of Past-President H. Wade MacLauchlan, the University of Prince Edward Island demonstrated our University's capacity to employ brains, ambition, and talent—*enhanced by education*—to challenge ourselves, to aim for the "next level up," and to succeed against standards of competitive excellence.

In the spirit of his example, the University of Prince Edward Island is proud to establish the H. Wade MacLauchlan Raised Expectations Awards, new entrance awards at UPEI recognizing selected students who demonstrate the greatest academic improvement during their Grade 10 to 12 school years and who go on to study at UPEI. These awards are funded through generous donations in honour of Mr. MacLauchlan's term as President.

GENERAL CRITERIA

The H. Wade MacLauchlan Raised Expectations Awards will be granted to a minimum of five (5) students graduating from a PEI public school who have demonstrated the greatest academic improvement from Grade 10 to completion of Grade 12 (minimum 10% improvement in an academic program or a switch from the general to academic program) and who are entering UPEI in the fall of their graduating year. No more than one (1) award will be granted at the same school.

AWARD VALUE

Minimum of five (5) \$1,000 awards.

APPLICATION PROCESS (application deadline: March 1)

Applicants will provide:

- Completed application form
- One reference from a teacher, principal or guidance counselor
- Official high school transcript (sent directly to the Registrar's Office)
- A personal statement about your academic experience at high school.
