AURA (Arts University Research Award)

DESCRIPTION

At the University of Prince Edward Island, there are several opportunities in Science, Engineering, and Medicine-related fields for students to compete for awards to support summer research jobs under supervision of a faculty member. Faculty members in the Faculty of Arts are highly productive researchers and creators and have much to offer as supervisors of student research. As well, there are many talented students who would benefit from the opportunity to conduct research in the Arts and Social Sciences, falling under the domain of the Faculty of Arts. These Arts University Research Awards (AURA) are established to enhance the student research efforts in the Faculty of Arts. The overall aim is to enhance student experience and training at the same time as fostering research culture and activity within the Faculty of Arts.

CRITERIA

Four awards will be granted to returning full-time undergraduate students (including honours) who will be conducting research in the Faculty of Arts during the summer months. Two awards per year valued at \$6,000 for full-time research (or equivalent part-time), and two awards per year valued at \$3,000 for part-time research will be available. Candidates will be required to complete and submit an application form and include a proposal defining the type and intent of their research to be supervised by a member of the Faculty of Arts. It is expected that the research could potentially result in a publishable peer reviewed paper, book, or book chapter, and/or conference presentation (co-authored with the supervisor), musical or dramatic performance, and/or contribute to the development of a grant proposal of the supervising faculty member.

Awards will be granted to students who:

- ✤ Are available to work on their project full-time for 12 weeks or part-time for 12 weeks, or full-time for 6 weeks in the case of the part-time award;
- Are able to present their work at an event hosted by the Faculty of Arts each Fall and submitted to UPEI's Arts Review

Student project descriptions should include a title, description of the project, and goals to be achieved. The project may include traditional research, or community-integrated/action research, or creative projects including but not limited to creative writing, the development of a musical work, or the creation of a curated educational exhibition.

One (1) Letter of Support

A letter of support must be submitted from a supervisory faculty member.
